Tree Program

New trees make great gifts! Choose from two options:

Adopt-a Tree (\$250): adopt a mature tree in a Seattle park; tree adoption certificate provided.

Any Park (\$200): plants a tree anywhere in Seattle, location not tracked.

Park-Specific (\$750): plants a tree in a known location you can visit for many years to come.

Tree Program Support: A gift of any amount for Tree Program Support will be used for ongoing planting, watering, and maintenance of Seattle's trees.

Bench Program

Donate new benches, or refurbish existing benches. Park bench dedications have a life-span of 15 years for new benches and 10 years for refurbishments. (See back for bench form.)

Yellow Swing Program

These ADA swings allow a wide range of users to sit deeply in the seat & use gravity to hold the user comfortably in place. The high back supports users with weak or no back & neck strength.

Picnic Table Program

Dedicate and refurbish an existing picnic table to enjoy the park with the whole family. Picnic table dedications have a life-span of 10 years for refurbishments. (See back for bench form.)

New park benches refers to the donation and installation of a bench within a park where none existed before. Seattle Parks & Recreation makes all decisions regarding placement of new park furnishings. New park furnishings are a great way to improve upon a park with need for additional seating or amenities. In most parks, a plaque is installed when a new bench is donated.

Refurbished benches and picnic tables refers to the renewal of an existing park bench or picnic table through removal of old wood back- and seatrests and replacement with new wood, and frame repairs as needed. Refurbishments are a wonderful way to improve upon existing park furniture for the enjoyment of all park-goers. In most parks, a plaque may be installed when a refurbishment is donated.

Donated furnishings will be installed after they have been paid for in full. Please send a check payable to Seattle Parks Foundation or discuss other payment options with the Program Manager.

Your signature on this form indicates that you have read both pages of this document, consulted with the Seattle Parks Foundation Bench & Tree Program Manager, and you understand that:

- 1) Location of all donated furnishings and language used on recognition plaques are subject to approval by Seattle Parks & Recreation;
- 2) As a tax-deductible donation, donated furnishings are property of Seattle Parks & Recreation, and will be maintained according to Seattle Parks & Recreation policy and priorities;
- 3) Furnishing donation terms are as follow: 15 years for a new furnishing and 10 years for a refurbishment. After that period, the furnishing(s) will be available for renewal with first right of refusal given to the original donor.
- 4) All trees and park furnishings donated through this program are property of the City of Seattle Parks & Recreation and are maintained at the same level as all other furnishings and landscape elements. Per City of Seattle policy, permanent plaques are not allowed on trees or any living landscape element.
- 5) In the event that significant steps have been taken to coordinate a bench or tree donation and a donor decides to cancel the process, a \$200 administrative fee will be retained.
